#### Old Testament

## |saiah 53:4-5

Surely He took on our infirmities and carried our sorrows; yet we considered Him stricken by God, struck down and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

#### Psalm 103:2-3

Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits — who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases.



#### New Testament

### Matthew 8:14-17

When Jesus arrived at Peter's house, He saw Peter's mother-in-law sick in bed with a fever. So He touched her hand, and the fever left her, and she got up and began to serve them. When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to Jesus, and He drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took on our infirmities and carried our diseases."

### 1 Peter 2:24

He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

So it becomes clear
Jesus' sacrifice on the cross
(as prophesized in Isaiah 53 &
Psalm 103, and fulfilled in
Matthew 8 & 1 Peter 2)
applies to both
spiritual & physical
healing!
