The Greek word for

Salvation is "Sozo"

which means:

saved, healed, delivered,
made whole, delivered, preserved

So it becomes clear that salvation means much more than simply being saved to go to heaven when we die.



According to Strong's Concordance, "sozo" means saved from the penalty and power of sin, being physically healed and cured of disease, and deliverance from enemies (e.g., devil, danger, etc.).
